4. Certificate on suitability of products in food

- 4.1 Poultry meat was received from slaughter and processing of healthy poultry at the poultry establishments, approved by the Competent Veterinary Service for supplying their production for export and operating under its constant supervision.
- 4.2 Poultry whose meat is intended for export into Russian Federation, have been subjected to veterinary inspection prior to slaughter, their carcasses and internal organs - to post-mortem veterinary-sanitary inspection by the State/official Veterinary Service.
- 4.3 Poultry meat is derived from clinically healthy birds that have been held in the territory of EU since hatching and originate from the premises and/or administrative territory, officially free from infectious diseases, including²:
 - Notifiable (as defined in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code) avian influenza - during the last 6 months in the territory of the EU Member State;
 - Other avian influenza viruses - during the last 3 months in the premises;
 - Newcastle disease - during the last 6 months in the administrative territory of the EU Member State (province, land, etc);
 - Ornithosis (psittacosis) - during the last 6 months in the premises.
- 4.4 Poultry originates from premises, considered safe on salmonellosis in accordance with the guidelines of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
- 4.5 The export to the Russian Federation of meat with poor organoleptic quality is not allowed.
- 4.6 Veterinary post-mortem inspection did not show that meat and internal organs have alterations indicative for contagious diseases, for being affected by helminths and for poisoning by various substances.
- 4.7 The temperature of the frozen poultry meat does not exceed minus 18 degrees Celsius, does not contain conservative substances, is not contaminated by salmonella, was not treated by colouring and odorizing substances, ionizing or ultra-violet rays, does not have dark pigmentation (except turkey and guinea fowl).
- 4.8 Poultry, from which meat is derived, were not subjected to the exposure of natural or synthetical estrogenic, hormonal, substances, thyrostatics, antibiotics, pesticides and other drugs, used prior to slaughter no later than authorised by instructions on how to use them.
- 4.9 Microbiological, chemical-toxicological and radiological characteristics of meat correspond to actual veterinary and sanitary rules and requirements of the Russian Federation.
- 4.10 The meat is recognized fit for human consumption.
- 4.11 Poultry meat must have official identification mark on package or block. Stamped label is placed on package in a way to ensure that opening of package is impossible without breaking the label.
- 4.12 Single-use containers and packaging material meet hygienic requirements.
- 4.13 The means of transport are treated and prepared in accordance with the rules approved in the EU.
