3. Sanitary attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, hereby certify, that the cattle meet the following requirements:

1. Estonia is free from foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, vesicular stomatitis, bluetongue and lumpy skin disease.
2. The exported animals were born and raised in Estonia or were legally imported.
3. The animals were not vaccinated for anthrax and vaccination against brucellosis is not permitted in Estonia.
4. With regard to bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE):
 - 4.1 Estonia is classified by the OIE as a country with controlled risk with respect to BSE.
 - 4.2 Estonia has a mandatory national cattle identification program that allows traceability of cattle.
 - 4.3 Regulations prohibiting the feeding of ruminant origin meat and bone meal to ruminants have been enacted by Commission Regulation (EU) No 56/2013 of 16 January 2013
 - 4.5 The animals were not fed with fodder of animal origin manufactured from processed protein of ruminant animals, excluding OIE exempted commodities.
5. The animals originate from herds:
 - 5.1 which are officially free of brucellosis and tuberculosis.
 - 5.2 in which no clinical cases of tuberculosis, brucellosis, enzootic bovine leukosis, caprine arthritis- encephalitis and paratuberculosis have been observed during the last three years.
 - 5.3 in which no clinical signs of Rinderpest, Contagious Bovine Pleuropneumonia, Bluetongue, Pasteurellosis, Foot and mouth disease (FMD), and Para Influenza have been observed during the last 12 months.
 - 5.4 in which no clinical signs of leptospirosis have been observed during the last 3 months.
 - 5.5 in which no clinical signs of anthrax were observed during the last 20 days.
6. The regions of establishments from which the cattle to be exported originate have been free of Vesicular Stomatitis for at least 12 months
7. The animals were kept in quarantine under the supervision of an official veterinarian for at least 21 days. During the quarantine, the animals were examined daily, did not present signs of infectious bovine rhinotracheitis (IBR) and had no contact with other animals.

4. Carrier's Certificate

Vehicles used for the transportation of cattle have been properly cleansed and fully disinfected before loading with products officially approved by the veterinary authorities.
