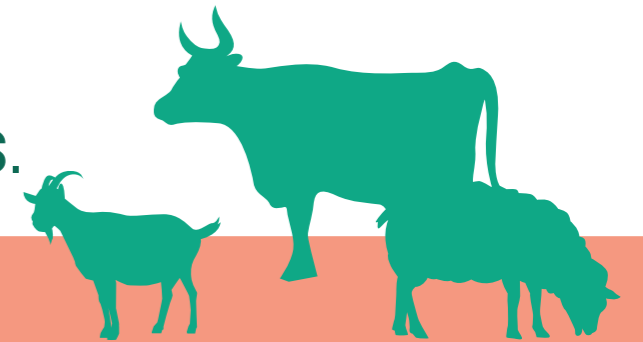




FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE

Bovines are mainly susceptible to the foot-and-mouth disease but it may affect also **pigs, sheep, goats** and many **wild even-toed ungulates**.



CLINICAL SYMPTOMS

Abortions and sudden deaths of newborns

Weight loss

Fever

Limping

Decline in milk production

Increased salivation

Blisters and sores

DIAGNOSING THE DISEASE

Damages on hooves causing the animals to limp

Increased salivation and sores on mucous membrane



Sheep and goats often show little symptoms and thus the disease may go unnoticed.
